CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

What is international credit mobility?

Europe has been funding the Erasmus program for over 25 years, which has enabled over three million European students to spend part of their studies in another higher education institution in Europe. The Erasmus+ program now broadens these opportunities, allowing mobility from and to other parts of the world (among the so-called "Program" and "Partner Countries"). This action also supports staff mobility (teaching or training).

The Erasmus+ program offers the opportunity for students to study and staff to teach or train in higher education institutions (HEIs) in places other than Europe. It also provides the same opportunities for staff and students from countries outside of Europe to apply for HEIs in Europe. This is known as International Credit Mobility and it is an activity under the Key Action 1 - Mobility.

This second phase of applications aims to fill the vacancies that were left available in the first phase of applications and will include a mobility period between December 1st, 2017 and May 31st, 2018.

How to apply

Applications from students and staff are made by e-mail. The candidate must submit it via email to icmka107@uevora.pt. Candidates will have to apply using the appropriate application form, available at www.iifa.uevora.pt. All communication with the candidate will be made by e-mail; therefore, it is very important that a valid email address is placed on the application. The application must be submitted before the deadline.

The application form must include the following documents:

- . *Curriculum vitae*
- . Diplomas and certificates of academic qualifications, school history / certificate of subjects made
- . Copy of passport or other identification document
- . One or more recommendation letters
- . Motivation letter
- . Official socioeconomic status or health status (in case it declares constraints at these levels)
- . Proof of contact and interest on the part of the University where it is proposed to go
- . Plan of activities to be carried out.

Application deadline

The application period will be from July 1 to July 14, 2017. Students, teachers and non-teaching staff may apply. The total number of scholarships is 14. Below is the table with the distribution of mobility grants for the period between December 2017 and May 2018. The results of the applications will be communicated to the interested parties via e-mail.

Selection criteria

To students:

Based on the evaluation of the documentation associated to the application: academic merit; motivation, knowledge and interest in the language and culture of the host country; proposed teaching-learning activity plan; socio-economic and health / physical condition of the candidates.

To academic and non-academic staff and doctoral students:

Teaching and non-teaching staff and doctoral students should also submit in their application any experience in previous mobility programs and justify how their application will benefit their work and those they intend to develop, as well as how it will contribute to an improvement in the functioning of the teaching-learning methodologies (in the case of teaching fellowships), of research and joint research methodologies (in the case of PhD fellowships), of academic and administrative management (in the case of non-teaching fellowships) procedures, as well as in terms of quality assurance and international cooperation. The teaching and non-teaching staff should also submit a proposal for a work plan.

Eligible Scientific Areas

The scientific areas eligible for students and teachers are Agriculture (Agronomy, Agrarian Economy, Animal Science and Rural Engineering) and Landscape and Landscape Planning. From Vietnam other scientific areas can be considered.
