A call for tenders is open for 1 Scholarship of «Research» within the scope of the project “MALAGUEIRA: PATRIMÓNIO DE TODOS: SUBSÍDIOS PARA A SUA CLASSIFICAÇÃO.”, ref: “**PTDC/ART-DAQ/32111/2017**” financed by national funds through FCT/MCTES, under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Architecture

Admission requirements:

The initiation to research grant (BII), is intended to carry out initial R&D activities by students enrolled in a higher professional technical course, a degree, an integrated master's or a master's degree, aiming at the beginning of their scientific training through their integration in the R&D project (PTDC/ART-DAQ/32111/2017).

According to FCT Research Grants Regulation No. 950/2019 of December 16, 2019, article 5, - **BII** (Initiation to Research Grants) cannot be awarded to those who have already benefited from research grants directly or indirectly funded by FCT, awarded under the Research Fellowship Statute.

The **BII** (Initiation to Research Grants) have a minimum duration of three months, and may be renewed up to the maximum period of one year.

Preferred admission requirements:

Knowledge, proven by portfolio and/or training courses in at least one of the following freeware Information Technologies (IT), namely: CAD - Computer Aided Design: SketchUp, FreeCAD, Fusion360, LibreCAD, or similar; BIM - Building Information Modelling: Graphisoft BIMx, Edificius by ACCA Software, Tekla BIMsight, Dynamo BIM, BIM Server, FreeCAD BIM; Image edition or creation and Illustration: Inkscape or GIMP and Paint.NET, Pixlr Editor or PhotoScape X; Rendering and animation: Lumion 3D type, Blender or Edificius by ACCA Software.

NOTE: Any other with similar characteristics and results.

Work Plan:

The researcher will be member of the project's research team, developing tasks necessary for its proper execution. The activities to be carried out by the Grant holder consist of supporting, developing and carrying out scientific tasks foreseen in the Research Project «Malagueira: Heritage of All: Subsidies for its classification», with special focus on the **activity «A3 - Representation, 3D Modeling and Mobile AR»** from the project. The main objective is to provide the digital bases for new understandings about the built and unbuilt public projects of Malagueira.

The intension is to create a technological tool for the systematization of information (drawings, plans, maps, photographic images, videos and links) indispensable for the understanding and consultation by professionals,

institutions and associations that seek a better and depth understanding about the history and meaning of Malagueira.

The Scholarship Holder will carry out the following tasks:

- Collaboration in the collection and survey of analog graphic elements and complementary bibliography;
- Analysis and treatment of all graphic elements (technical/rigorous drawings and design sketches) about Malagueira;
- Execution of digital models of the different housing typologies, equipment and public spaces, existing and planned;
- Support the organization of project events;
- Presentation of an article in a scientific journal, with the supervision of one of the members of the research project team.

Applicable legislation and regulations:

The granting of the Research Scholarship will be carried out upon the signing of a contract between the University of Évora and the scholarship holder, as set in the template https://www.fct.pt/apoios/Minuta_Contrato_Bolsa.docx, pursuant to the Research Scholarship Statute (Law No. 40/2004 of August 18 and Decree-Law No. 123/2019 of August 28) and in accordance with the legislation and Regulation of Research Grants of the Foundation for Science and Technology, IP in force, regulation nº950/2019 of December 16, 2019: <https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/regulamento.phtml.pt> and other applicable rules.

Workplace:

The work will be developed in the spaces provided by CHAIA – Centre for Art History and Artistic Research in the city of Évora, under the scientific guidance of the Professor Doctor Pedro Guilherme.

Duration of the scholarship:

The scholarship will have duration of 3 months, starting on June of 2022. The scholarship contract may be renewed until the end of the funding project's budget allocation (PTDC/ART-DAQ/32111/2017).

Amount of monthly maintenance allowance:

The amount of the BII grant (Initiation Research Grants) corresponds to € 486.12 according to the table of values of grants awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in the Country (<http://fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>), with payments made monthly, by check or bank transfer.

Selection methods:

The selection methods to be used will be the candidates merit based upon its (A) a curriculum evaluation. Or if the jury deems it necessary, a non-presential (B) interview may take place through a digital platform, recorded for joint evaluation by the jury and with the written consent of the candidate. In case of selection interview is used, it will have the value of 30% and the curricular evaluation of 70%.

Rating criteria

In the (A) curriculum evaluation, the following will be considered:

- Academic training - 0-6 values.
- Ability and mastery of representation and communication of architectural projects (models, 3D models, photomontages, drawing, etc.) - 0 - 6 values.
- Motivation letter, indicating the answer to the requested tasks - 0 - 6 values.
- Proficiency in Portuguese and English - 0 - 2 values.

In (B) the interview will be considered:

- The candidate's profile;
- Knowledge related to the history of architecture; construction and representation;
- The ability to work in a team;
- Autonomy and creativity.

Advertising/notification of results:

The final results of the evaluation will be publicized, through an ordered list alphabetically, by final grade obtained, posted in a visible and public place at CHAIA - Centro do História da Arte e Investigação Artística (Palácio do Vimioso, Largo Marquês de Marialva, nº 8, 7002-554 Évora), being the candidate approved notified through email or official letter.

To ensure the right of prior hearing of interested parties, the Final Classification project will be announced by any written means to all interested parties.

After communicating the provisional list of the results of the evaluation, candidates have a period of 10 working days to express their opinion in a preliminary hearing of interested parties.

Application deadline and submission of applications:

The tender is open from 4 to 30 of May of 2022 and the results of the selection will be published by 27 of May of 2022.

Applications must be formalized, obligatorily, by sending an application letter, with the following documents:

- Letter of motivation (500 words max.) indicating to what extent the candidate's profile can bring added contributions to the project;
- Detailed Curriculum Vitae;
- Portfolio of the work carried out and collaborations;
- Certificate of qualifications;
- Documents proving enrollment or ownership of the academic degree and/or diploma, or a valid enrollment certificate in an academic degree course leading to a diploma in Architecture;
- Document proving the country of residence, residence permit or other legally equivalent document, valid on the scheduled start date of the scholarship;
- Other supporting documents considered relevant.

For the purposes of application, the evidence may be replaced by a declaration of honor signed by the candidate, but the failure to demonstrate that evidence, in the contracting phase, possession of the required degree on the deadline for application or the non-presentation of proof of enrollment in the study cycle or non-degree course, for scholarships with this component, imply the cancellation of the candidate's application.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution in accordance with Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of August 16 and Ordinance No. 33/2019, of January 25th.
