



**CIDEHUS - Interdisciplinary Center for History, Cultures and Societies of the University of
Évora - Project UIDB/00057/2020
Competition for Research Scholarship for Graduate – 1 vacancy**

June 17, 2022

Tenders are open for the award of a Research Grant for Graduates within the scope of CIDEHUS - Interdisciplinary Center for History, Cultures and Societies of the University of Évora, Project **UIDB/00057/2020**, funded by FCT/MCTES - OE, in the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Hotel Management or Tourism

Admission requirements: The scholarship is intended for Graduates. Candidates must have a degree in Hotel Management or Tourism (eliminated factor) and be enrolled in a cycle of studies leading to the attribution of academic degrees or non-degree awarding course (eliminator factor); average degree equal to or greater than 14 values (eliminating factor); Cambridge English: First (FCE) certificate or equivalent (preferred factor); experience in writing scientific texts (preferred factor); experience of participation in scientific conferences (preferred factor); experience in the application of interviews and application of questionnaires via interview (preferred factor); and availability to travel in the territory corresponding to the Alentejo (Dark Sky Alqueva Territory) and the city of Lisbon.

According to the FCT Research Grants Regulation nº950/2019 of December 16, 2019, articles 3 and 6, candidates for **BI (Research Grants)** must fulfill, as a condition for the granting of the grant, the effective insertion in study cycles leading to the attribution of academic degrees or in courses not awarding an academic degree. Courses that do not award an academic degree correspond to the courses provided for in subparagraph e) of paragraph 3 of article 4 of Decree-Law no., including the course plan in one or several areas of research in the unit.

Work Plan: The scholarship holder will collaborate in the development of several activities associated with the project, mainly in the following activities:

- 1) research and archive of relevant literature on the subject studied;
- 2) Support in the preparation and application of interviews and questionnaires (in person and/or online);
- 3) Support for writing texts;
- 4) Support in organizing webinars.

The works will be developed within the scope of the project “Can positive and self-transcending emotions induced through astrotourism experiences promote pro-environmental behavior in tourists?”

Applicable legislation and regulations: The granting of the Research Scholarship will be carried out upon the signing of a contract between the University of Évora and the scholarship holder, as set in the template https://www.fct.pt/apoios/Minuta_Contrato_Bolsa.docx, pursuant to the Research Scholarship Statute (Law No. 40/2004 of August 18 and Decree-Law No. 123/2019 of August 28) and in accordance with the legislation and Regulation of Research Grants of the Foundation for Science and Technology, IP in force, regulation nº950/2019 of December 16, 2019: <https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/regulamento.phtml.pt> and other applicable rules.

Place of work: The work will be developed at CIDEHUS - Interdisciplinary Center for History, Culture and Societies of the University of Évora, in the University of Évora, under the scientific guidance of Professor Áurea Lucília de Oliveira Rodrigues.

Duration of the scholarship: The scholarship will last for 6 months, starting in August 2022. The scholarship contract may be renewed until the end of the funding project's budget.

Amount of monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the scholarship corresponds to €875.98, according to the table of values of the scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in the Country (<http://fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>), with payments made monthly, by check or bank transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods to be used will be based on the following parameters: Curriculum evaluation (100%).

The jury may call the candidates for a selection interview if considered necessary or in the event of a tie. In this case the selection interview will have the evaluation of 50% and the curriculum will have the evaluation of 50%.

Advertising/notification of results: The final results of the evaluation will be published, through an alphabetically ordered list, by the final grade obtained posted in a visible and public place of the Palácio do Vimioso – CIDEHUS, with the approved candidate being notified by email.

Under the terms of the interested parties' right to a prior hearing, the Final Classification project will be announced by any written means to all interested parties.

After communicating the provisional list of the evaluation results, candidates have a period of 10 working days in which, if they so wish, to express their views at the prior hearing of interested parties.

Application deadline and submission of applications: The tender is open from 21st of June to 5th July of 2022 and the results of the selection will be published by 8th July of 2022.

Applications must be formalized, mandatorily, by sending an application letter accompanied by the following documents: Cover letter, *Curriculum Vitae* and *Certificate(s) of qualifications*.

For the purposes of application, evidence may be replaced by a declaration of honor from the candidate, but failure to demonstrate, in the contractualization phase, possession of the required degree by the deadline for application or failure to present proof of enrollment or enrollment in a study cycle or non-degree awarding course, for scholarships with this component, imply the cancellation of the candidate's evaluation.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution in accordance with Decree-law no. 66/2018, of August 16 and Ordinance no. 33/2019, of January 25th. The presentation of the certificate is mandatory for the signing of the contract.
