Undergraduate Research Scholarship - 2 vacancies**

**2 of November of 2022**

A call for tenders is open for 2 Scholarship(s) for undergraduate students within the scope of the project **UIDB/00057/2020** financed by national funds through FCT/MCTES - OE, under the following conditions:

**Scientific area:** Informatics

**Admission requirements:**

An undergraduate registration in Informatics or similar; presentation of the CV; proof of knowledge and experience in programming, according to the work plan below.

According to FCT Research Grants Regulation No. 950/2019 of December 16, 2019, article 5, **BII** (Initiation to Research Grants) cannot be awarded to those who have already benefited from research grants directly or indirectly funded by FCT, awarded under the Research Fellowship Statute.

**Work plan:**

1. Development of computer programming that involves knowledge of
  - a. Python; Javascript; HTML (preferably HTML5); NodeJS;
  - b. PHP (mainly for recovery of old sites); databases: SQL; NoSQL;
2. Development of works involving:
  - a. headless CMS; static page generators; management and maintenance of WEB servers; Docker; PM2; ElasticSearch; Streamlit.
3. Dealing with data migration;
4. Maintenance of the CIDEHUS server;
5. Support and technical support to CIDEHUS Researchers;
6. Attend to specific technical courses.

**Applicable legislation and regulations:** The granting of the Research Scholarship will be carried out upon the signing of a contract between the University of Évora and the scholarship holder, as set in the template [https://www.fct.pt/apoios/Minuta\\_Contrato\\_Bolsa.docx](https://www.fct.pt/apoios/Minuta_Contrato_Bolsa.docx), pursuant to the Research Scholarship Statute (Law No. 40/2004 of August 18 and Decree-Law No. 123/2019 of August 28) and in accordance with the legislation and Regulation of Research Grants of the Foundation for Science and Technology, IP in force, regulation nº950/2019 of December 16, 2019: <https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/regulamento.phtml.pt> and other applicable rules.

**Place of work:** The work will be developed at CIDEHUS of the University of Évora, under the scientific guidance of the Doctor Renata Vieira.

**Duration of the scholarship(s):** The scholarship will have a duration of 6 months, starting on January, 2023. The scholarship contract may be renewed up to 6 months or until the end of the funding project's budget allocation.

**Amount of monthly maintenance allowance:** The amount of the scholarship corresponds to € 486,12, according to the table of scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in Portugal (<http://fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>), payments being made monthly, by check or bank transfer.

**Selection methods:** The selection methods to be used will be the following: curriculum evaluation and interview, with the respective valuation of:

- curriculum evaluation - 60%

- interview in Portuguese - 40%

In the curriculum assessment the rating and score will be as follows:

- 12th year school average and results of undergraduate subjects already completed

In the interview on curriculum, motivation, experience, and knowledge in computer science (to rank from 0 to 20)

**Advertising/notification of results:** The final results of the evaluation will be publicized, through an ordered list by final grade obtained posted in a visible and public place in Palácio do Vimioso, being the candidate (a) approved notified through email.

To ensure the right of prior hearing of interested parties, the Final Classification project will be announced by any written means to all interested parties.

After communicating the provisional list of the results of the evaluation, candidates have a period of 10 working days to express their opinion in a preliminary hearing of interested parties.

**Application deadline and submission of applications:** The tender is open from 4 of November of 2022 to 18 of November of 2022 and the results of the selection will be published by 25 of November of 2022.

Applications must be formalized, obligatorily, by sending an application letter (by email) with the following documents:

- Curriculum Vitae; other proof of works performed;

- Certificate of qualifications;

- Proof of registration in the undergraduate course of the respective area.

For the purposes of application, the evidence may be replaced by a declaration of honor signed by the candidate, but the failure to demonstrate that evidence, in the contracting phase, possession of the required degree on the deadline for application or the non-presentation of proof of enrollment in the study cycle or non-degree course, for scholarships with this component, imply the cancellation of the candidate's application.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution in accordance with Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of August 16 and Ordinance No. 33/2019, of January 25th.
