A call for tenders is open for 2 (two) Master's Research Scholarships within the scope of the project *Building Respectful And Violence-Free Gender-Inclusive Environments in The World of Work*, BRAVE - WOW, *Grant Agreement 101195252*, financed by European Union, CERV- 2024 - DAPHNE Program (CERV Lump Sum Grant), under the following conditions:

Scientific area: Psychology

Admission requirements:

Master's degree in Psychology.

Preferential factors are experience in providing services in research and/or science dissemination activities and enrollment in a doctoral program in the 2025/2026 academic year.

As set forth FCT Research Scholarship Regulation No. 950/2019 of December 16, 2019, article 3 and 6, candidates for "BI" (Research Grants) must comply as a rule condition for the award of the scholarship, the effective inclusion in study cycles leading to the attribution of academic degrees or in courses not leading to an academic degree. Courses that do not confer an academic degree correspond to the courses provided for in subparagraph e) of paragraph 3 of article 4 of Decree-Law No. 74/2006 of 24 March and must be developed in a higher education institution in association with at least one R&D unit, including a course plan in one or several research areas of the unit.

Work plan:

Interact in English with the BRAVE-WOW project partners.

Responding, under supervision, to requests made by the various BRAVE-WOW project partners to the University of Évora.

Responding, under supervision, to tasks for which the University of Évora is responsible in the BRAVE-WOW project, namely carrying out literature reviews and participating in research design meetings.

Monitor the implementation of the pilot studies to be carried out in the four BRAVE-WOW project countries.





Availability for national and international travel.

Carrying out various administrative tasks necessary for the continuation of the project, in interaction with elements of the University of Évora that interact with the project.

Carry out their doctoral thesis (where applicable) within the scope of the project's themes, and in accordance with the guidelines received by the supervision team, in order to create the synergies necessary to carry out the project and the doctoral thesis.

Have at least one of the BRAVE WOW team members from the University of Évora as their doctoral supervisor.

Applicable legislation and regulations: The granting of the Research Scholarship will be carried out upon the signing of a contract between the University of Évora and the scholarship holder, according to the version in Annex I, pursuant to the Research Scholarship Statute (Law No. 40/2004 of August 18 and Decree-Law No. 123/2019 of August 28) and in accordance with the legislation and Regulation of Research Grants of the Foundation for Science and Technology, IP regulation nº8131/2024 of July 22, 2024: https://files.diariodarepublica.pt/2s/2024/07/14000000/0035300366.pdf, and in the Research Grants Regulations of the Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P. (Regulation no. 950/2019, of December 16, as amended).

Place of work: The work will be developed at Center for Research in Education and Psychology - CIEP, of the University of Évora, under the general coordination of the Administrator of the University of Évora and the scientific guidance of the doctoral members of the project team, who must draw up an opinion on the final activity report of the scholarship (**Annex II**), according to the draft in **Annex III**. In some phases of the project, the place of work will be the University of Coimbra, general coordinator of the BRAVE-WOW Project.

Duration of the scholarship(s): The scholarship will have a duration of 12 months, starting on July of 2025. The scholarship contract may be renewed up to a maximum of 30 months or until the end of the funding project's budget allocation (...).

Amount of monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the scholarship corresponds to 1309,64€, according to the table of scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in Portugal (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2024/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM_atualizacao-2024.pdf), payments being made monthly, by check or bank transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods to be used will be the following:

I - CURRICULAR ASSESSMENT (CA) - 50% weighting;

The CA aims to verify the candidates' qualifications and level of previous involvement in research and science dissemination activities, namely the sub-criteria:

- Curricular valorization (CV) 50%;
- Final classification of master's degree (FCM) 15%;
- Participation in research and/or science dissemination activities (RSDA) 35%.





The Curricular Assessment (CA) score can be translated into the following formula:

$$CA = (0.5 CV) + (0.15 FCM) + (0.35 RSDA)$$

II - INDIVIDUAL INTERVIEW (IE) - 50% weighting

The purpose of the individual interview is to find out the candidate's motivation for the job, as well as to ascertain the professional and personal skills and characteristics considered necessary and/or desirable for the job, namely:

- Professional motivation (PM) 25%
- Ability to express oneself and verbal fluency in Portuguese and English (AEVF) 25%
- Knowledge relevant to the activities to be carried out (KRAC) 30%
- Ability to work in a team, resilience and tolerance to pressure, commitment to work and meeting deadlines (AWRTC) 20%.

The Individual Interview (IE) score can be translated into the following formula:

$$EI = (0.25 \text{ MP}) + (0.25 \text{ AEVF}) + (0.3 \text{ KRAC}) + (0.2 \text{ AWRTC})$$

RATING AND FINAL CLASSIFICATION (FC)

The final classification to be awarded to candidates must be higher than 12 (twelve) points, with candidates obtaining a lower classification being eliminated, and is obtained using the following formula:

$$FC = (0.5 CA) + (0.5 IE)$$

For tie-breaking purposes, candidates will be ranked according to the score obtained in the following sub-criteria, in order of precedence: Curricular Valorization (CV), Professional Motivation (PM) and Participation in research and science dissemination activities (RSDA).

Advertising/notification of results: The final results of the evaluation will be publicized, through an ordered *list* by final grade obtained posted in a visible and public place at Colégio Pedro da Fonseca, being the candidate approved notified through email.

To ensure the right of prior hearing of interested parties, the Final Classification project will be announced by any written means to all interested parties.

After communicating the provisional list of the results of the evaluation, candidates have a period of 10 working days to express their opinion in a preliminary hearing of interested parties. On the basis of the final selection list, a reserve selection list will be drawn up, to be used for the possible recruitment of new scholarship holders within the scope of this project, up to the





duration of the scholarship, which may be used in the event of the first-placed candidate withdrawing, failing to submit the mandatory documentation, or in the event of the scholarship holder canceling their scholarship early. In the event that none of the candidates demonstrates that they have the right profile to carry out the work plan, the jury reserves the right not to award the scholarship in the competition.

Application deadline and submission of applications: The tender is open from <u>24 of June to 8</u> of July of <u>2025</u> and the results of the selection will be published by <u>15 of July of 2025</u>.

Applications must be formalized, obligatorily, by sending an application letter with the following documents: Curriculum Vitae, certificate of qualifications and other supporting documents considered relevant.

For the purposes of application, the evidence may be replaced by a declaration of honor signed by the candidate, but the failure to demonstrate that evidence, in the contracting phase, possession of the required degree on the deadline for application or the non-presentation of proof of enrollment in the study cycle or non-degree course, for scholarships with this component, imply the cancellation of the candidate's application.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require registration by a Portuguese Institution in accordance with Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of August 16 and Ordinance No. 33/2019, of January 25th.

FIRST CLAUSE

THIRD CLAUSE

The Second Party undertakes to carry out the attached work plan, the content of which he/she declares that he/she has taken full cognisance of and accepts unreservedly, from the above-mentioned start date and on an exclusive dedication basis, under the terms of article 5th of the Research Fellow Statute.





FOURTH CLAUSE

FIFTH CLAUSE
 The monthly maintenance allowance awarded is (€,00). The Second Grantor also benefits from personal accident insurance for the duration of the grant, the conditions of which he/she declares to have read and accepted without reservation. The following scholarship components are also added (specify the applicable components in the terms set out in the FCT Research Grant Regulations).
SIXTH CLAUSE
The First Party may cancel the grant and the Second Party may be obliged to refund all or part of the sums received in the following cases:
 a) Serious and repeated failure to comply with the Second Party's obligations under the Research Grant Holder Statute and the FCT Research Grant Regulations, for reasons attributable to the Second Party;
b) A negative evaluation of the Second Grantor's performance by the supervisor or the host organisation under the terms of the FCT Research Grant Regulations;c) False declarations by the Second Granting Party on matters relevant to the award and renewal of the grant or to the assessment of its development.
SEVENTH CLAUSE
Without prejudice to the provisions of the previous clause, this contract shall terminate automatically:
 a) Upon completion of the activity plan; b) End of the period for which the scholarship is awarded; c) Repeated non-compliance by one of the parties; d) Revocation by mutual agreement; e) Establishment of a legal employment relationship with the host organisation.
EIGHTH CLAUSE
1. The rights and duties of the parties are those resulting from the provisions of the Research Fellow Statute.
2. The Second Party declares that he/she has read the Research Fellow Statute and the applicable Regulation(s) and undertakes to comply with their provisions.
NINTH CLAUSE
It is agreed between the parties, that in case of need and to settle all questions arising from this contract, the District Court of (name of the District) shall have jurisdiction, expressly waiving any other.





TENTH CLAUSE

Any changes to be made to the contract in the course of its performance shall be the subject of prior written agreement.

ELEVENTH CLAUSE

- 1. This contract shall take effect on the date it is signed by both parties.
- 2. The grant awarded under the terms of the FIRST CLAUSE of this contract may be renewed for additional periods of (...) months, up to a maximum of (...) months, under the terms of article 15 of the FCT Scholarship Regulations.
- 3. [ONLY FOR RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIPS, otherwise withdraw]: The award of the academic degree (or diploma) during the term of this contract shall not affect its effects, and the grant referred to in the preceding paragraph may be renewed at a later date, provided that it is aimed at carrying out activities that are indispensable for the completion of the project (...).
- 4. The concrete definition of the activities referred to in the previous paragraph is the responsibility of the First Party, after hearing the Second Party and the Scientific Advisor, and they must be included in the agreement to be signed, as provided for in the previous clause.
