Research Grant for Bachelor's Degree Holders - 1 Vacancy

A call for applications is now open for the award of a Research Grant for a Bachelor's Degree Holder to carry out tasks within the scope of the research project entitled PATH to succeed: Personalized study skills, Approaches, and Technologies for helping Higher education students Succeed with reference 2025-1-LV01-KA220-HED-000361579/P4, co-financed by the European Commission of the ERASMUS+ Programme, under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Psychology

Admission Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in Psychology or an equivalent qualification in the required Scientific Area (this is an eliminatory criterion).
- Enrollment in a Master's in Educational Psychology (this is an eliminatory criterion).
- Scientific experience in developing and validating instruments using SPSS.
- Preferably, knowledge and experience in educational intervention contexts (children, teachers, parents).
- Strong skills in data collection, analysis, and literature review.
- Proficiency in English and Portuguese (these will be the working languages).
- Strong ability to work autonomously and in an organized manner.
- Proven experience in European projects.

As set forth FCT Research Scholarship Regulation No. 950/2019 of December 16, 2019, article 3 and 6, candidates for "**BI**" (Research Grants) must comply as a rule condition for the award of the scholarship, the effective inclusion in study cycles leading to the attribution of academic degrees or in courses not leading to an academic degree. Courses that do not confer an academic degree correspond to the courses provided for in subparagraph e) of paragraph 3 of article 4 of Decree-Law No. 74/2006 of 24 March and must be developed in a higher education institution in association with at least one R&D unit, including a course plan in one or several research areas of the unit.

Work Plan:

The work plan for this grant aligns with the PATH project activities, focusing on the development and dissemination of project outputs, including:

- Supporting the implementation and necessary contacts for launching the MOOC/project outputs.
- Assisting in the development of project tools/outputs.
- Helping organize and facilitate workshops, including engagement with the academic and professional community as planned in the project.
- Supporting the preparation of project reports and deliverables and the potential publication of scientific results.





Applicable legislation and regulations: The granting of the Research Scholarship will be carried out upon the signing of a contract between the University of Évora and the scholarship holder, according to the version in Annex I, pursuant to the Research Scholarship Statute (Law no. 40/2004 of August 18, as amended) and considering the provisions of other applicable legislation and regulations, namely, the Research Grant Regulations of the University of Évora (published by Order no. 8131/2024, of July 22, 2024), and the Research Grant Regulations of the Science and Technology Foundation, I.P. (Regulation no. 950/2019, of July 22, 2024).

Workplace: The research activities will take place at the University of Évora – CHRC of the University of Évora, under the general coordination of the University's Administrator and the scientific supervision of Professor Dr. Adelinda Candeias, who will provide an evaluation of the final activity report of the grant (Annex II), following the model in Annex III.

Duration of the Grant: The grant will have a duration of six (6) months, starting in November 2025 potentially extendable.

Monthly Maintenance Allowance: The amount of the scholarship corresponds to €1040.98, according to the table of scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in Portugal (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2025/02/Tabela_valores_SMM_2025.pdf), payments being made monthly, by check or bank transfer.

Selection Methods:

The selection process will be based on:

- 1. Academic Qualifications (50%)
 - o Classification: 50%
 - o Relevance to the field: 50%
 - 2. Curriculum Analysis (50%)
 - Scientific Activity: 50%
 - Experience in the required topics: 50%

Publication and Notification of Results:

The final evaluation results will be publicly posted in a visible location at the University of Évora (**Colégio Luís Verney – School of Health and Human Development**). Successful applicants will also be notified via email.

To ensure the right of prior hearing of interested parties, the Final Classification project will be announced by any written means to all interested parties.





After communicating the provisional list of the results of the evaluation, candidates have a period of 10 working days to express their opinion in a preliminary hearing of interested parties. Based on the final ranking list, a reserve selection list will be drawn up, to be used for the possible recruitment of new scholarship holders within the scope of this project, up to the duration of the scholarship, which may be used in the eventuality of the first ranked candidate withdrawing, failing to present the mandatory documentation, or in the event of the scholarship holder canceling their scholarship early. In the eventuality that none of the candidates demonstrates the profile required to carry out the work plan, the jury reserves the right not to award the scholarship.

Application Deadline and Submission Process:

The application period is **October**, **07th** – **October**, **21th 2025**, and the selection results will be published by **November**, **10th**, **2025**.

Applications must be submitted via email and must include:

- A cover letter
- Curriculum Vitae
- Academic degree certificates
- Other relevant supporting documents

For application purposes, candidates may initially submit a declaration of honor instead of official documentation. However, failure to provide the required documents during the contract signing phase will result in disqualification.

Academic degrees obtained abroad must be officially recognized by a Portuguese institution according to Decree-Law No. 66/2018 of August 16 and Ordinance No. 33/2019 of January 25. The official certificate is required for the grant contract to be signed. More information is available at: Recognition of Foreign Degrees

SIXTH CLAUSE
The First Party may cancel the grant and the Second Party may be obliged to refund all or part of the sums received in the following cases:
 a) Serious and repeated failure to comply with the Second Party's obligations under the Research Grant Holder Statute and the FCT Research Grant Regulations, for reasons attributable to the Second Party;
 b) A negative evaluation of the Second Grantor's performance by the supervisor or the host organisation under the terms of the FCT Research Grant Regulations;
c) c) False declarations by the Second Granting Party on matters relevant to the award and renewal of the grant or to the assessment of its development.
SEVENTH CLAUSE

) End of the period for which the scholarship is awarded;
c) Repeated non-compliance by one of the parties;
d) Revocation by mutual agreement; e) Establishment of a legal employment relationship with the host organisation.

- 4. The concrete definition of the activities referred to in the previous paragraph is the responsibility of the First Party, after hearing the Second Party and the Scientific Advisor, and they must be included in the agreement to be signed, as provided for in the previous clause.
